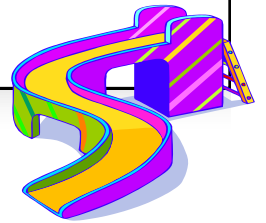


Walkabout

During Walkabout, adult volunteers will walk around the playground and interact with children in ways which promote positive student behaviors, engage students in physical activity and foster a greater sense of community. This is a great opportunity for volunteers to see their children in action during a favorite part of the day—Recess!



What will volunteers do?

- Volunteers will spend time at recess walking around, talking to children and encouraging them to participate in games or activities. Volunteers are encouraged to stay after the recess and enjoy lunch with their children. Elementary school children LOVE to see their family members at school.

What is the time commitment?

- K-2nd lunch recess is 11:45-12:05 and 3rd-5th lunch recess is 11:15-11:35.
- Volunteers can sign up for one recess or both. They can sign up for as many sessions as they would like—one day a month, one day a week or just one time—whatever fits the family schedule best!

What is required in order to sign up?

- Complete a WSP background check form (yearly)
- Complete the online School Volunteer Training as well as the Walkabout Training. and review the updated Clark Volunteer Training on the school's website. (one time only)
