IMPORTANT DATES

- **10/23: Turn in your minutes, you will be entered into a special prize drawing**
- **10/30: Turn in your minutes, you will be entered into a special prize drawing**
- **11/1: Last day of Read-A-Thon! Turn in your minutes and all the fundraising money.**

All fundraising money is due to PTA by 11/01 to be eligible for book fair prizes.
